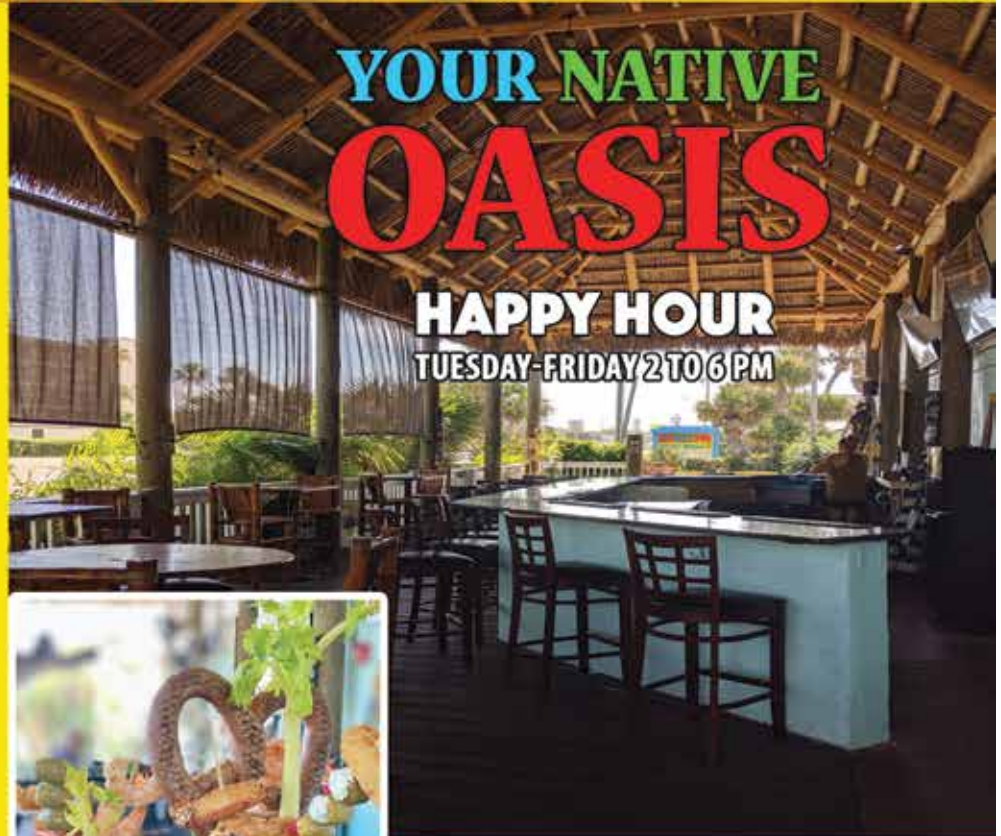

What sets this seafood festival apart from others is that it runs through a 100 percent volunteer effort. All preparation, whether it be on the grounds or with the purchasing, cooking or serving of the various menu items is accomplished by volunteers of the community. No regular food vendors have ever been on site. All booths are run with volunteers; many booths are made up of family members, often times having several generations working along side one another. It is this complete volunteer effort that makes this festival unique. The festival is open on Saturday from 9 am to 7 pm and Sunday from 9 am to 5 pm.

There is a stage with ongoing live entertainment. Every year the festival begins both days with an opening ceremony including prayer by Patrick Pittenger, Star Spangle Banner performance by Chloe Chase and a Flag raising by BSA Troops. 

Nate Bargatze

Nate Bargatze isn't a household name...yet. The Nashville Tennessee comedian has spent the last 20 years touring and will come to the King Center for two shows on Friday, March 24th.

Bargatze's material originates from everyday life. His deadpan delivery is characteristically his own. The Atlantic published an article dubbing him the 'nicest man in standup'. He is one of the few comedians on the scene right now that performs a clean routine that is suitable for all ages.

Bargatze began his stand-up comedy career at The Boston in New York City. He has appeared multiple times on shows such as *Late Night* with Conan O'Brien and *The Tonight Show* Starring Jimmy Fallon, being one of the first to perform stand-up on the latter. He was part of Fallon's *Clean Cut Comedy Tour* in 2013, also winning New York's Comedy Festival and the Boston Comedy Festival that year. He wrote for the Spike TV Video Game Awards and has performed multiple times for American armed forces in Iraq and Kuwait. He was mentioned by Marc Maron as a "comic who should be big" and by Jim Gaffigan as one of the top up-and-coming comics.

Bargatze's first stand-up album, *'Yelled at by a Clown'* (2014), made it onto the Billboard Top Ten Comedy Charts for two weeks, peaking at No. 2. He released his second album, *Full Time Magic*, in coordination with his Comedy Central special in May 2015. In 2017, he had a half-hour special released on *Netflix* as part of The Stand-ups.

In March 2019, Bargatze released an hour-long Netflix special titled *The Tennessee Kid*. It was filmed outside Atlanta, Georgia. His next standup special, *The Greatest Average American*, was released by Netflix in March 2021. It was filmed outdoors at Universal Studios Hollywood and was nominated for the 2022 Grammy Award for Best Comedy Album.

In January 2023, his latest standup special, *Hello World* was released on Amazon Prime Video. It was filmed in the round at the Celebrity Theater in Phoenix, Arizona. In the special, Bargatze talks about his extended family, growing up in a conservative household, as well as the ups and downs of having kids. He also talks about his favorite pastime: golf.

Bargatze is also hosts the *Nate-land* podcast, which draws inspiration from *Seinfeld* as it often turns into a "podcast about nothing". The show also includes Aaron Webber, Brian Bates, and Dusty Slay.

It should be noted that Bargatze will turn 44 the day after the Melbourne stop of the tour. Show times on March 24th are 7pm and 9:30pm. Tickets were still available as of this writing at www.kingcenter.com.

The Recreation Of Honey Miller

Brevard County has a lot of colorful characters. Some pop up seemingly out of nowhere, then disappear. We are all lucky that singer/songwriter/band leader Dave Miller isn't a flash in the pan. His band, Honey Miller, has weaved in and out of the music scene for over a decade. Now Miller is yet again poised to recreate himself.

To know today we must first start with the past. As he states online, he began to add musicians to his solo outings "sometimes accidentally, sometimes with intent." Miller played with such dignitaries as Jeff Stanton and Ryan Perez (Rex Goliath), Ana Lusk and Anthony Darama (Brevard Busking Coalition/Oranga Tanga), just to name a very few. Honey Miller, in all of their incarnations, have played it all. From tiny eateries in Cocoa Beach, to a two-night stand at the King Center, audiences both young and old have been entertained.

"I am currently collaborating with Jeff Stanton, Loosey Ross and Vince Baldino currently creating folk/EDM fusion music", explains Miller. "That is the new direction." Over the years, Miller has composed and performed surf, funky rock, all with intelligent and often times personal, honest lyrics. The instrumentation may change, but the sound remained consistent.

"I'm still writing blues rock & rock songs. I am in the process of licensing, multiple pop songs, which

we are combining together with EDM beats," he continues. Miller's clever use of using the past and the technology available today sets him apart from the other solo entertainers on the scene. "Jake Salter of Tru Phonic encouraged me to use backing tracks as a solo act in live performances. Best advice I've had in five years, thank you Jake Salter! I truly could not do this without all the great musicians in Brevard County over the past 14 years."

The solo spotlight suits him. "I no longer have a band," he quips somewhat thinking out loud. Miller has taken this opportunity to continue marketing the music which has garnered him a quite impressive following. "I'm giving away one of my albums for free via QR code complements of the locations I'm playing at. I will drive everybody to those locations. So far, it's starting to work as the fans have been showing up. "I'm gonna market the living f--k out of this thing until I'm dead," he deadpans like

only he can. "I am having more fun than a barrel of monkeys and people love it. Even the people that didn't like me that drove me to keep going and, of course, my friends who encouraged me to keep going!"

With all that he has going on that is new, Miller hasn't forgot what has gotten him here in the first place. "I'm releasing an old Honey Miller tune that we found in the archives featuring Jeff Stanton on the guitar. It's called 'I'm Not a Junkie'." He stated that the song will be available for download and streaming by press time.

The music scene is alive and well as long as Dave Miller is around. Currently doing the solo thing, it wouldn't be surprising if the next project is with a philharmonic. Whichever project he chooses to do, we are all lucky to bear witness.

Check out everything Honey Miller, including solo dates, on their social media. Dave is currently performing solo in three locations, The Tiny Turtle, Hogan's Irish Pub, and The Cottage Pub. If you know Dave Miller, you know that he is a "merciless" promoter and supporter of his music. Rightfully so.

Apocalypse 3.0





Gordon Lightfoot

Gordon Lightfoot has recorded 21 Albums and has five Grammy nominations. His songs have been aired regularly for over 50 years, earning him Radio Singles Chart Positions in North America achieved by few others. Lightfoot's radio hits in the USA have earned Five #1s, Five Top 10s and Thirteen Top 40 hits. In Canada he has earned Sixteen #1s, Eighteen Top 10s and Twenty One Top 40 hits.

Aside from his success in writing, singing and performing his own songs, Lightfoot has found fortune in having his songs recorded and performed by other great artists including: Bob Dylan, Elvis Presley, Johnny Cash, Hank Williams, Jr., Marty Robbins, Jerry Lee Gordon, Judy Collins, Johnny Mathis, Anne Murray, Olivia Newton-John, Sarah McLachlan, Barbra Streisand, Peter Paul & Mary, Harry Belafonte, Jane's Addiction, Richie Havens, Glen Campbell, Toby Keith and George Hamilton IV.

In June of 2012 Lightfoot's legacy was further enhanced when he was inducted into the Songwriters Hall Of Fame. Lightfoot was honored for his role in defining the folk-pop sound of the 1960s and '70s. In his native Canada, Lightfoot has been decorated with the highest honors bestowed to a civilian including the Governor's General Award and the Companion to the Order of Canada honor of merit. He has also won 17 Juno Awards - Canada's equivalent to the Grammy Awards.

Guess Who

The Guess Who was the most successful Canadian rock group of the late 1960's and early 1970's, and Canada's first rock superstars. The songwriting team of guitarist-singer Randy Bachman and lead singer-keyboardist Burton Cummings wrote such classic songs as "These Eyes", "Laughing", "No Time", "No Sugar Tonight", and "American Woman" (the first song by a Canadian band to hit No. 1 on the Billboard Hot 100 chart) before Bachman's departure in 1970. The string of hits continued with "Share The Land", "Albert Flasher", "Rain Dance" and "Clap for the Wolfman", among others, until Cummings left to pursue a solo career in 1975.

The Guess Who won two Juno Awards and a Governor General's Performing Arts Award, and was inducted into the Canadian Music Hall of Fame, Canada's Walk of Fame, the Canadian Songwriters Hall of Fame, and the Canadian Music Industry Hall of Fame.

The Guess Who proudly have 11 Gold albums, 16 Top-10 Hits, and five #1's over their storied career and continue to tour. The Guess Who officially broke up in 1975, though bassist Jim Kale and/or drummer Garry Peterson have toured and recorded under The Guess Who name since 1977. "The Guess Who" name is currently legally owned by former bassist Jim Kale, who is now retired, but has allowed the name to be used by the current lineup of musicians.

Saltwater Hippy Band

One of the great things about the Space Coast is our beaches, filled with warm breezes, beautiful sun rises, calming waves, and enjoy the comfort of the salt water. Based here in Brevard County, The Saltwater Hippy Band adds to that feel with southern rock, along with some laid back classics and a touch of country rock. What's more laid back than that hippy feeling! The band has been together almost five years now and solidifying the roster in 2019, they feel that they have now the right mix of musicians and personalities.

The band started through some responses on *Craigslist* as singer Tim Hattaway joined up with some players who all were already jamming together. These musicians were starting back a band that had been on hiatus. It kind of sputtered for awhile while they searched for players with matching goals and musical influences. With the band solidified, they started playing at various venues and after one of the original members left, it was decided to rename the band. The four that remained together have become musical

brothers and are having a great time entertaining people, making new friends and growing and improving as musicians. Tim said, "I think our length of time together, our common goals and musical interests and our friendship very positively impact our music." As the norm, everyone threw out some suggestions and one of them was Saltwater Hippy Band. Sort of perfect for this group of guys. Tim told me: "The name reflected our beach side attitude and it attached also to the music we played and pretty much describes the members of the band." The band plays songs by groups like the Allman Brothers, Marshall Tucker, Lynyrd Skynyrd, Eric Clapton, Stevie Ray Vaughan, Chris Stapleton, David Alan Coe, etc... as well as a few originals. So let's meet the band!

Singer and Harmonica player Tim Hattaway grew up in middle Georgia in the 70's, just a few miles down the road from the home of *Capricorn Records*. Needless to say, southern rock was a big part of his life growing up. Bands like the Allman Brothers, Marshall Tucker, Lynyrd Skynyrd, ZZTop, Hendrix and Led Zeppelin were some of his favorites back then and still are today. He really enjoys all types of music though and thinks it shows in the variety of music that the band plays.

He and his wife moved to Cocoa Beach about 8 years ago after retiring to be near family. He had played with a friends band in Georgia for many years and was anxious to make some music connections here in their new home. It wasn't easy to connect initially and was frustrating until he got a call in response to one of his posts. This led to the formation of the band. He's very thankful for his band brothers, they love playing music for the people and hope to continue for many years to come! A fun fact: During his time playing and singing in Macon he was fortunate to be invited to perform at the "Big House." This is the former residence and the now museum of the Allman Brothers Band. He shared a stage with some true music legends such as Jaimoe, Chuck Leavell and Paul Hornsby. Tim is big into hiking and the outdoors. He, of course, loves our beaches.

Guitarist and backing vocalist Charlie Amrich moved to Brevard 15 years ago, played in several local bands (including Dangerfish and Electric Tide) then met up with Tim through his *Craigslist* ad back in 2018. Charlie's music and guitar influences include most of the usual suspects; Clapton, Hendrix, Zeppelin, Jeff Beck, Santana, Van Halen, along with a healthy dose of southern rock bands like The Allman Brothers, Marshall Tucker, The Outlaws and Lynyrd Skynyrd. Charlie: "I'm always amazed by a great technical guitarist, but also love the raw, rough around the edges energy of Neil Young, Tony Iommi (Black Sabbath) and the experimentation of The Edge from U2. To me, it doesn't matter if there's a thousand notes or one, it's if you feel something when you hear it. One thing that's a lot of fun with this band is, there's plenty of room to improvise on some songs and give it our own twist." He added, "The local music scene is really incredible; that there are so many great, live venues in a county the size of Brevard. And you

can't beat playing an outdoor gig in the middle of winter, with palm trees, a tiki bar or the ocean as a backdrop!"

Compromised of scene vets Dave Clark and the power couple of Bonnie and Andy Harrington, this track rocks. For fans of Lana Del Ray and Portishead (Google it), not sure if this is a record only project or if live performances are in the works. In the meantime, go their individual social media for updates.

We have some peeps that need your help. Since last column, Casket Culture singer **Josh Doyle** was involved in a horrific car crash after a show which ended up totaling his car and mangling his arm. He is on the mend but in need of funds for the extensive surgeries. Also ongoing is guitarist, promoter and all-around nice guy **Carlos Satana** (no, not THAT one). He is set to get a cornea transplant this month. I have affectionately dubbed it 'Make Carlos See Again'. You can purchase *Deep Six Promotion* shirts with all the proceeds going to the surgery. There are also separate *Go Fund Mes* set up for both Josh and Carlos online if you feel so inclined. Ok guilt trip over. Or is it?

Stacy Lynn Cartechine, lead singer of the local band **Cover Story**, went through something every parent fears. Her son Alex died of hypertrophic cardiomyopathy at age 21 last December. This is the same condition that my stepson Mathew had prior to getting a heart transplant in 2015. The condition often goes undiagnosed as kids look healthy on the outside. "He came home from work, took a shower and literally just dropped and died," Cartechine said. "He had sudden cardiac arrest." "This could happen to your kid," she continued.

Cartechine got involved with *Who We Play For*, a nonprofit charity, to help ensure other kids get screened for undiagnosed heart conditions. She is now leading the charge to eliminate these deaths in young people through affordable heart screenings.

The organization began after Cocoa Beach High soccer player Rafe Maccarone went into sudden cardiac arrest right before a game in 2007. He died the next day. His friends started the *Play for Rafe Foundation*, which later changed to its current name. It helped Cartechine realize she wasn't alone. She met 19-year-old James Gibson through the group. He was flagged at high risk during a heart screening to

Rigg's Outpost FISHING REPORT MARCH FORECAST

By Captain Pompano Rich



Brevard March weather is almost Spring but cool in the mornings warming to 78 degrees. It's a great time to visit us. Especially since Spring Break is not till April. The beaches and Inlets will provide 12 miles of condo free lined beaches. I have been fishing the East Coast of Florida for 60 years! Melbourne has always been my March destination. The ocean, the beaches, the inlets and the estuary abound with tasty easy to catch critters.

On calm days a party boat adventure is inexpensive and truly a productive experience. I am talking a mile off the beach in shallow waters. Slightly silty water one can see the outlines of patch reefs while headed for your destination. Virtually each one of these underwater islands abounds in colorful and feisty 2 to 5 pound bottom dwellers.

Mate rigs everyone up with chicken rigs. (to catch fish... Whut) I found this funny whilst lacking caffeine! Three hook leaders with 3 pieces of the bait of the day. Within minutes the rod tip is rattling and you're pulling in who knows what. Mate pointing at a reddish fish coming up. Yes, a tasty lane snapper, and oh there's a silvery fish at the base of the leader. So it's an ocean pogy. Your fish receives a marking and placed in huge cooler. Back at the dock the mate will clean your fish. Of course a generous tip is welcome.

Head to the beaches south of the town Indian Atlantic and there are numerous parks and beach entries in route to the Inlet. It's a remarkable ocean for so many coastal species. The best is the Carolina Traveler. El Pompano! Here from the Carolinas to scarf up crustacea and enjoy warmer sea temps. My fave by far.

Bring a seven and a 10 two piece rod and pick up some sand spikes. The 10 to reach roughly 80 yard sand bars and intersect the poms. The seven to throw lures at bluefish, mackerel and jacks that pound the surface knifing thru balls of bait. Rigg's will teach you which pompano and whiting rigs to use to reach optimal success. Live and frozen bait is never an issue. The Pompano King Pin Capt. Matt Burr (Momma B's charters) works full time. I can honestly say that I don't know anyone in Sebastian/Melbourne that can out perform Matt. He's on Facebook. If you want to learn it all including Inlet fishing for snook, redfish, drum, flounder, pompano and permit he's the guy. Rigg's Outpost has it all.
