Space Coast State Fair Presents

MOLLY HATCHET & FRAN COSMO

As the weather gets "cold" and winter arrives, it's time to head to the fair. The 36th Annual Space Coast State Fair comes to Space Coast Daily Park in Viera November 4th-20th. You can get your corn dog fix, ride the Tilt A Wheel and jam out to some good old Classic Rock. The Southern Rockers Molly Hatchet comes to town on November 18th and Fran Cosmo, formally of Boston on November 19th. Both shows along with 'Wee Wee Wee Pig Races' and 'Queen B Spooky Circus Sideshow' are included in the fair admission.

Despite there being no original members left, Molly Hatchet continues to perform live as of 2022, and their current lineup features half of the Lighting Strikes Twice—era album lineup (keyboardist John Galvin and guitarist Bobby Ingram) as well as drummer Shawn Beamer, bassist Tim Lindsey and vocalist Jimmy Elkins, who replaced McCormack in 2019. In June 2022, The band has announced that a new Molly Hatchet album is in the works and intended for a late 2023 release.

The band released its biggest hit 'Flirting with Disaster' in 1980. The band formed in 1978 in Jacksonville and was contemporaries with another iconic band Lynyrd Skynyrd. Various albums both studio and live releases followed over the years. Most recently, guitarist Steve Holland died from Covid complications in 2020 at the age of 66.

Fran Cosmo has been a featured vocalist for the band Boston. In 1994, Cosmo was featured as the sole lead vocalist on the platinum Boston album Walk On which reached continued page 16

THREE DOG NIGHT

Finally, they will come to Melbourne. Three Dog Night, the Rock'n Roll Hall of Fame worthy band comes to The King Center on December 8th. Their hits include 'One', 'Mama Told Me' and 'Joy To The World', just to name a few. The band has survived music trends, member deaths plus a pandemic, and are back on the road playing multiple dates a week all over the US.

"It took me 30 years but I'm finally playing The King Center," says drummer and Brevard native Pat Bautz. He and keyboardist Howard Laravea called in from a tour stop last month in New Jersey. "It's cold," he says with his signature smirk heard in his voice.

The band has been more active the last few months, post Pandemic. What started out as weekend trips is now extended to 4 or five shows in a row. The Florida run also includes shows in Ft. Pierce, Daytona Beach and The Villages.

Bautz and his wife Laurie have also set their sights on living in Florida again, at least part time. They had built a house a few years ago in Colorado Springs, Colorado to be closer to family. It was always their intent to come back to Sunshine State. "One guy says it will be move in ready by Thanksgiving, another guy says the first of next year," says Bautz. There are plenty of gigs to be had in between to keep Bautz and the band busy.

Three Dog Night started as a band in 1967. They continue to sell out multiple nights in cities for their loyal fan base all the while making new ones. Their social media presence is impressive. The Three Dog Night official Facebook page boasts over 700,000 followers. There are numerous fan pages and group discussions. Many have called for their induction into the Rock n Roll Hall of Fame, an honor that has somehow eluded them. One possibility is determining how

many of nearly 3 dozen members past and present members would be included.

Another development with the band is that they are playing new material in concert. The song 'Prayers of the Children' has been in the setlist as of late. Bautz has made it a point to take and post pictures of the audience from behind his drum set. The 'Pat DrumCam' as the band has nicknamed it, shows off the various venues they play as well as the thousands of fans that are entertained at each stop of the tour

Don't look for Three Dog Night to join the trend of a multiple band festivals any time soon. "Our fans are older and wouldn't necessarily do well standing for hours outside waiting for us to perform", Bautz explains. "They're much more comfortable in an air-conditioned theater sitting down." The idea of traveling overseas doesn't appeal to him either. "We would have to travel with a team of doctors and have extra luggage for our medicines," he says as both he and Laravea hold back their laughter.

Keyboardist Laravea has been with the band since 2017. He was formally with Frankie Valli and The Four Seasons. The two get along so well that he moved from Nashville to Melbourne a decade ago. The issue of who gets the guest list for the King Center show is brought up. "We'll split it evenly," Bautz jokes, noting that with area shows happening there's less chance that they'll get taken off a Christmas card list if they can't get everybody into the show.

Outside of live shows, Bautz is kept busy in the studio. "It was easier (staying home) during Covid," he remarks. He runs realdrumstudio.com and mixyoursongs.com, both song-based situations where he will participate on a song. He also heads up RDSrecording.com; a full-service studio and production company that has worked with local bands Part One Tribe and Tru Phonic. With him moving back East (they plan on living in FL about half of the year), we can hope that he will once again be part of the local music scene.

Three Dog Night at The King Center will be a party for sure. A homecoming for Bautz and an introduction for Laravea to his new home. 'Joy To The World' indeed.

The Space Coast Music Festival reboot (the original multi day festival ran 2010-2015) is in its third year. Orlando based rock reggae group The Supervillians will headline this year's event, happening Saturday, November 5th in the Eau Gallie Arts District.

The band was founded in 1997 by drummer/lead singer Dom Maresco and guitarist/vocalist Scott 'Skart' Suldo' when they were in their late teens. Now 7 full length albums, 3 EPs and thousands of miles driven playing the continental US and Bahamas, the band will play alongside 97 bands on 7 stages for SCMF.

The band also features Brevard native BJ Hall (Abandon The Midwest) on bass. Maresco comments on the longevity of the band: "Really, just being stupid and never quitting", he laughs. "We love music, I love to be on stage and perform. We're grateful that the fans keep coming, and after a while their kids start coming. It's multi-generational."

Brevard County and surrounding areas have hosted The Supervillians on many occasions including a 2-day beach bash years ago held in Satellite Beach. Their most recent local appearance was last month in Cape Canerval. This time will be different as the SCMF is a free, family friendly event. "We've played rock festivals and jazz festivals," he continues. "Being the genre that we are, we kind of fit in all over the place."

This year's festival looks to continue the success of both 2019 and 2021's editions. Back is the kid's stage featuring up and coming musicians and the groups they have formed. The BMX exhibition is also back, giving attendees visual entertainment in addition to all the local music. New this year is Best Fest; the traditional night before pre party, featuring the 15th anniversary of the local band Best Supporting Actor, along with Rainy Angel, Lily of the Valley, Damion Suomi, Dollmaker and headliners PagingMrHerman. Both events are free and open to the public.



Lou's Blues 3rd Legendary Karaoke Contest

Congratulations to the winners Bry White (champion), Erika Densler (best female & fan favorite) and Chad Nibert (best male) of the 2022 3rd annual Lou's Blues Legendary Karaoke Series! The Finals took place October 12th in front of a packed house. Once again Master of Ceremony Robert Bowen has put on a class-act show exposing some of Brevard's hidden talent.

All contestants had applied for the six-week contest. They would go through four weeks of preliminary rounds, one week of semifinals, and one week of finals. Due to the threat of hurricane Ian the semi-finals were scrubbed on September 28th, postponed to October 5th.

Now, Oct. 12th, 7 finalists took the stage, each performing 2 rounds of one song each. Most even had a wardrobe change to be "in character." The judges did not just consider the voice, important was also the appearance, stage presence and professionalism. It must have been a hard call because all contestants were at their best and very impressive. Robert Bowen, Producer, MC, and host lead the contestants

through an American Idol style competition with professionalism, wit, and humor. Cindy Walker, Lou's Blues Karaoke DJ, spun the tracks for the contestants' performances while Jeff Ross, Lou's Blues Audio Engineer, insured the quality was at its highest. Each contestant was brought on stage as Robert read out the winners from the judges' envelopes. The winner Bry White received a \$500 prize and the honor to sing with one of Brevard's most popular band, Ana and Switch. There was no third prize this year, instead the second prize (each \$250) went to the best female performer Erica Densler and the best male performers Chad Nibert. - A little trivia: Bry White came in second in 2021, and Erika Densler was last year's fan favorite as well.

The singing contest opened with 2021 champion Michael James and the "break" was filled with a performance by 2019 champion Van Floyd. Any show is as good as the music production, the show host along with the contestants. This is a first class event with very talented amateur singers - no comparison to the regular club favorite entertainment. What both, however, have in common is the fun factor. Each of the contestants admitted to a nervous state of mind, the adrenalin was pumping. But besides all that, it was great fun - for the contestants as well as for the audience. Once again, this karaoke contest has earned its legacy fair and square.

#7 on the Billboard charts and produced three hit singles, including "I Need Your Love", which climbed to #4 on the Mainstream Rock Chart, and "Walk On" which reached #14. Upon original singer Brad Delp's return to Boston for the concert tour, the two shared vocals in concert, where Delp said Cosmo covered "the really tough high parts". In 1997, Cosmo was again featured on two of the songs on Boston's 'Greatest Hits' album, and took an even larger role in the 2002 album Corporate America with the addition of co-production to his credits as vocalist. He sang lead vocals on five of the album's songs and played guitar on one track as well.

Cosmo performed in Boston tours from 1994 to 2004, and currently performs in the band Cosmo with his son, Anton Cosmo. He also sings in the World Classic Rockers. Cosmo released his first album with his band in 2006, titled Alien.

The concerts are free with fair admission. On November 18th Zeddemore will open for Molly Hatchet. For more information go to www.spacecoast-statefair.com

Quantum Entanglement

"Quantum entanglement is the physical phenomenon that occurs when a group of particles are generated, interact, or share spatial proximity in a way such that the quantum state of each particle of the group cannot be described independently of the state of the others, including when the particles are separated by a large distance." - Wikipedia

"Quantum entanglement is a phenomenon observed at the quantum scale where entangled particles stay connected (in some sense) so that the actions performed on one of the particles affects the other, no matter the distance between two particles." - www.astrogeeksco.com

During this time when I have a multitude of time to do nothing, I spend some of my time reading either quantum physics stuff or Egyptology. In this article, I would like to discuss the very bizarre concept of Quantum Entanglement, even though it is a very abstract kind of concept. This will twist your brain cells around some. Now before you say "Damn, Chuck, how many pain killers did you take before you read this?!?", let me say I'll try to explain the basics in as concise a manner as I can, and what it means to me.

Let's start by saying this is seen on a quantum level, or stuff we can't see without very special equipment (neutrons, electrons and photons). For this example, we'll just use basic shapes, say a square and a circle. Under normal deduction, there are four outcomes: Both the objects are circles, the first object is a circle and the second a square, the first object is a square and the second is a circle, and both the objects are squares. That is it. That's all the possibilities. These objects are not dependent on each other (or entangled). If you change the shape of one object, it has no effect on the other.

In the quantum world, when both objects are entangled, if one object is a circle, the other is also a circle. If one object is a square, the other object must also be a square. They mirror each other's properties in this way, no matter the distance between them. For example, if we have one object in Topeka, Kansas and another object in Sri Lanka, and they are entangled, and we observe the ob-


ject in Topeka is a square, then we can assume the object in Sri Lanka is a square. Say the object in Topeka wants to be a circle, that information is instantly transmitted to the object in Sri Lanka. Both become circles. Ok, let's just stop right here.

In this overly simplified explanation, the information must travel faster than the speed of light, which is impossible. Since we're talking about light, we must acknowledge that light exists as both, a particle and a wave. So this information, what is it? It's not either. Herein lies the conundrum. The whole thing gets much more complex once we add color to the shapes, but that's a whole other article! Anyway, one example I was reading used a pair of twins, separated on either side of the planet, as an example. He started out by talking about "Twin Telepathy", saying he didn't know if it was real or not. I had to write him immediately to tell him without a doubt, it is real.

I know I've often written about my twin experiences with Billy. We used to say the same sentences at the same time, have the same dreams, write the same songs when we were apart, etc. There are two instances that exemplify this quantum entanglement theory that were brought to mind, though. One time I was living in the Keys, Billy was in Alaska. That's pretty far apart! That year, we sent our mom the exact same Christmas card. Exactly The Same! This was before cell phones were ubiquitous but pay phones were all the rage. Every so often I would call my dad to check in. Every time I did, for three years, Billy would call him within minutes. My dad thought we were setting this up.

As identical twins, we were always aware that this cosmic thing was there, we just didn't know how to explain it or say what it is. Perhaps it's quantum entanglement at its basic level. Perhaps quantum entanglement can show us how we are all connected and tied into the universe as well. Maybe the photons of Billy are floating in the universe somewhere prompting me to write this. All I know is, I've always believed in quantum entanglement, and I'm sure there are many twins out there that would agree.

More than 50 products are made with golden grass amongst them purses, necklace, bracelets, earrings, hats and much more. The art of molding capim dourado is passed on from generation in the villages where it first started in the Jalapao region, being an important source of income for many families. Nowadays it has gained a lot of popularity and is present not only in Tocantis, but also widely used in Brazil. It was granted a geographic identification tag, which is a certification that the product possesses certain qualities and is made according to traditional methods.

On her last trip Siara brought back some unique hand crafted figurines. One thing is for sure, nothing stays long on the shelves, and there is always something new when you get to the Happy Turtle next time.






HORNBELLY OFFERS FRESH WILD SEAFOOD

MIFF - "DON'T KEEP IT UNDER THE HAT"

Lattending the now world famous Melbourne Independent Film Festival written, directed, produced and starring the one and only Terry Cronin and 3 Boys Productions with a familiar cast of characters we like to call the "Cronies." Honestly, I think I'm the only one that calls them that, but I'm trying to start something here so fingers crossed it'll catch on by next year.

Every year I am thoroughly impressed with how much Terry improves and tweaks what has become a staple weekend here in our little, but famous (I'm learning), corner of the world. No joke- every year this event just gets bigger and better.

Once again this year the MIFF was held at the Oaks 10 Theater in Melbourne, Florida. I love this for a few reasons. First of all, the Oaks 10 is the picture of a classic theater filled with the kind of pageantry and décor befitting of the magic that is Hollywood and film culture in general. Secondly,

the Oaks 10 is locally owned and I love that we have our own film festival and its venue is a home grown business.

Thursday night kicked off the fest with a showing of a short film slash music video called The Voyagers directed by Ian Bertel (photo top left). The video stars local violinist Char Good (photo top right) and features her rendition of the Eagles' Hotel California while she plays herself through the lobby, up the elevator and across the roof of the Hotel Melby in downtown Melbourne. Occasionally throughout the video you can catch local graffiti artist Maslow running around tagging pieces on the building. Maslow actually did all of the graffiti work on the exterior and interior of the hotel. There is also a mysterious black hatted character glimpsed a few times, but no one told me the secret about who that is possibly Bertel himself?

"We shot all the footage in one night and then went into editing and finished just as the sun was coming up." Bertel told the MIFF audience before the screening. "It was a very long night, but really has kind of highlighted my life so far."

Later, at the after party, Ian told me he picked Hotel California because

when it was written *SoCal* was really starting to grow into itself musically and artistically, and he thought the rising of Hotel Melby is symbolic of Melbourne, Florida about to do the same.

After The Voyagers there was a premiere screening of Michael Baumgarten's new film Hollywood Laundromat - a gritty and often hilarious look at the kinds of things that can happen at an overnight Laundromat in Hollywood. According to the man himself this film was shot in only 6 days with some of the dialogue improvised for character. No stranger to the MIFF, Baumgarten's movies are always a treat and he's always good to answer questions about his process. He's also, I've noticed, keen to share the limelight with his cast and crew which I find refreshing. This year he crossed the country with actress Natasha Blasick, originally from Ukraine and her husband Martin Blasick who created all the music for the film and performed in a scene of the film.

When asked why he keeps coming back to Melbourne every year Baumgarten replied, "I keep coming back every year because of the people





Rigg's Outpost FISHING REPORT NOVEMBER FORECAST

It's hardly noticeable while driving Brevard in Autumn. The beaches are lined with diverse palms, scrub pines and all the scrub that is indigenous to Florida. Our Estuary is mangrove lined and placid driftwood islands that show remnants of hurricanes. If you are looking for what the Indians and Ponce DeLeon enjoyed hundreds of years ago, then that's us!

Moving on my tour guide man ship is following the fish to provide an impactful catching experience. I will provide you the road map and you might accept my suggestions. Once you decide to target or choose to freelance you will land in "Rigg's Outpost Land".

October was a signal that November will be easy for vermillion and mangrove snapper fishing. If it's red and scaly in Florida, it's delicious! These are easy picking for party boat fishing and inexpensive. Always nice to be comfortable on a big craft when the weather could turn. The big adventure will be chasing the cobia on chartered swift moving vessels. Binoculars out, the mate and Captain are looking for marked eruptions on the sea. The correct birds will help in locating a dolphin or a cobia. It's cobia time. Ranging 10 to 50 pounds muscle bound bruisers are here. You won't believe the battle. Delish on grill or blackened, cobia are a rare treat.

How about filling your cooler with Spanish mackerel and bluefish? Put gear in vehicle. Average spinning rods, plugs and jigs. Drive to beach, park and send associate to the berm. Look for birds, bait and eruptive activity. You don't see that, drive to the next beach park.

Mr. Pompano is our silver tourist. Originating in the Outer Banks and headed for the Palm Beaches. They are migrating thru and will continue all month. This challenge will best be met with colorful tackle and the right baits. Rigg's has the best everything! Plus I make the optimal tackle to catch pompano! Be sure to bring a 9 or 10 foot rod to clear rough seas and hold in rip currents. Two piece light weights will be terrific. Captain Matt Burr at Rigg's is the man to see. He is Pro Staff and beach guides for pompano, tarpon and redfish. Want to catch a 60 to eighty pound shark, he's your man! He works there daily and Anthony and his sales guys will give you a card. If the condition are right he will help you nail the fish. Make Rigg's your one stop shop and enjoy your trip to the fullest!


